Around the Ponies

Small Animals



- ✓ Gentle handling only
- ✓ Cuddles & huggies only

Hygiene



- ✓ Wash hands after contact
- ✓ No eating in animal areas

- ✓ Avoid contact with sheep
- ✓ During handling events

- Sheep due to give birth, or with newborn lambs, can carry infections (toxoplasmosis, chlamydia, listeria) that may be harmful during pregnancy.
